NEWS LETTER

1. Executive Summary of April 2024 Market Report by Cotlook

- o In April, New York futures for cotton experienced a continued decline, with the July contract dropping sharply by 1,045 cent points to close at 81.52 cents per lb. Turnover and open interest decreased, mainly due to speculative investors closing their positions in the expiring May contract. Certificated stocks continued to rise. The Cotlook A Index, reflecting international offering rates, decreased by 730 cent points to 88.30 cents per lb.
- O In China, Zhengzhou cotton futures closed lower at 15,700 Yuan per ton, with active import market participation earlier in the month due to international cotton prices moving to a discount compared to the China Cotton Index. Despite a slower pace as the month progressed, significant net new sales for China were reported in USDA export reports. The Department increased its forecast of China's cotton imports for 2023/24 in its April supply and demand estimates.
- o Planting progress for the 2024/25 crop was positive in Xinjiang and the United States, with favorable weather conditions. Pakistan and India also reported favorable progress in planting, with India expecting above-average rainfall crucial for cotton output during the Monsoon season.
- o In Egypt, planting of shorter staple varieties began, with potential increases in the area sown. Sowing progress was good in Greece despite an expected decline in planted area compared to the previous year.
- o In the Southern Hemisphere, Brazil's cotton crop outlook remained positive, with record output predicted. Rains in Argentina disrupted early picking stages but were beneficial to plants. Australia faced harvest delays due to heavy rainfall, raising concerns about crop grade composition.
- Octton Outlook's forecast of world raw cotton output for 2023/24 saw a slight reduction in April, offset by increases for Brazil, the United States, and other countries for 2024/25. Consumption figures remained unchanged, resulting in a slightly narrower margin between production and consumption for the current season. Global ending stocks for 2024/25 are forecast to rise substantially compared to the previous month.

2. ICE cotton futures consolidate as focus shifts to WASDE report

- o ICE cotton futures retreated on Thursday despite a weaker dollar and strong weekly export sales data, as caution sets in ahead of a monthly federal demand and supply report. Cotton contracts for July CTc1 fell 1 cent, or 1.2%, to 79.05 cents per lb by 12:08 p.m. ET (1608 GMT), after rising as much as 3.3% in the previous session.
- The dollar weakened against most currencies after economic data showed more signs of softening in the U.S. labor market.
- The U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) weekly export sales report showed net sales of 253,700 running bales (RB) for 2023/2024, up noticeably from the previous week and the prior 4week average.

- The report also showed exports of 249,600 RB, up 39% from the previous week and up 2% from the prior four-week average.
- o Investors focus is now on the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) monthly World Agriculture Supply and Demand Estimates (WASDE) report on Friday.
- o "Rains this week should further improve moisture for cotton germination in West Texas, Coastal Bend, northern and south-eastern Delta, and much of the Southeast," weather forecaster Maxar wrote in a weekly note.
