

DOMESTIC COTTON CROP SCENARIO

The second meeting of Cotton Crop Assessment Committee (CCAC) was held on 14th December,2020 under the chairmanship of Federal Secretary, Ministry of National Food Security & Research (MNFS&R), Islamabad. According to estimates released by Cotton Crop Assessment Committee meeting, the cotton production during the current season will be at 7.70 million bales against the fixed targets of 10.89 million bales. Punjab assessed production at 4.9 million bales, Sindh gave target of 2.5 million bales, KPK 0.0065 million bales and Baluchistan gave 0.291 million bales. The major reasons behind this decline were the challenges of low seed germination, onslaught of Locust, high pressure of pests, COVID-19 pressure and recent heavy rains damaging the standing cotton crop substantially in Sindh and Punjab provinces. Sindh reported that the recent rains and floods have damaged 26.7% cotton crop. About 80% crop was damaged in districts of Umerkot and Mirpurkhas. Whereas in Punjab, the affected districts are D.G Khan, Muzzafar Garh, Rajan pur and Multan. Details of province-wise assessment of cotton production is given in table as below:



Figure-I: SEED COTTON PRICES DURING NOVEMBER, 2020



Figure-II: COTTON SEED PRICES DURING NOVEMBER, 2020



Figure-III: COTTON SEED CAKE PRICES DURING NOVEMBER, 2020



The graph above shows that the prices of raw cotton during the month of November, 2020 depicted decreasing trend and were recorded at Rs.10,146 per 40 kg as compared to Rs. 10,346 in October, 2020. COTTON YARN PRICES:

The Cotton Yarn prices of 21's and 30's count witnessed increasing trend during the month of November, 2020. The prices were recorded at Rs.1,925 and Rs.2,171 per bundle of 4.5 kg respectively as compared to Rs.1,808 and Rs.2,024 per bundle in previous month. However, the same counts in the corresponding month of last year were recorded much lower at Rs. 1,656 and Rs.1,832 per bundle respectively. Details are given as below:

The table above indicates that the exports of raw cotton and it's related produce witnessed increasing tendency in October, 2020. The raw cotton exports enhanced to 206 metric tons valuing Rs.41 million as compared to 34 metric tons valuing Rs.7 million in September,2020. However, the exports in October, 2019 recorded much higher at 899 metric tons amounting to Rs. 216 million, showing an increase of 505.88 percent in quantity and 485.71 percent in value over September,2020.

The table above shows that the imports of raw cotton during October, 2020 witnessed decreasing trend and recorded at 51,856 metric tons amounting to Rs.13,633 million as compared to 56,561 metric tons valuing Rs. 14,689 million in September,2020. Whereas the imports in October,2019 recorded at 5,536 metric tons amounting to Rs. 1,440 million, showing a decrease of 8.32 percent in quantity and 7.19 percent in value over September,2020.

ECONOMICS OF COTTON AND COMPETING CROPS

Cotton a Kharif crop, competes with rice, sugarcane and other crops for land, water and other farm resources in the area where the cultivation of all other crops is technically feasible. Mainly cotton faces indirect competition from sugarcane, the annual crop which keeps the land throughout the year. The economics of cotton and competing crops has been analyzed on the basis of inputs-outputs costs paid and received growers during 2019-20 year. The summary of various indicators for Punjab and Sindh are presented in table as under:

REGIONAL COTTON SITUATION





Cotton area in China has witnessed continued decline by 2.7% to 3.2 million hectares in 2020-21 as compared to 3.3 million hectares in 2019-20. Where as production is expected to increase by 0.86% to 5.85 million tons in 2020-21 as compared to 5.80 million tons in last year. Similarly, consumption is expected to rise by 10.3% to 8.00 million tons in 2020-21. Imports by China are estimated at 2.0 million tons, indicating an increase of 28.7% over previous season. Stock level in China is estimated to decline by 2.2% to 8.738 million tons in 2020-21 as compared to 8.938 million tons in 2019-20.

2. INDIA

Cotton area in India is estimated to decline by 5.0% to 12.6 million hectares in 2020-21 as compared to 13.3 million hectares in 2019-20. However, production in India is projected to rise by 2.1% to 6.20 million tons in 2020-21 as compared to 6.07 million tons in previous year. Similarly, mill consumption is expected to recover by 15.3% to 5.13 million tons but will still allow for exports to increase in 2020-21. India's increased production in 2020-21 season should decrease imports and provide additional opportunities for exports. However, Indian exports are projected at 1.2 million tons for the season based on a production of 6.2 million tons for the 2020-21 season and excess stock from the previous season.

3. INTERNATIONAL COTTON SITUATION 2018-19



World cotton area estimates has been decline by 7.9% to 31.509 million hectares in 2020-21 as compared to 34.212 million hectares in 2019-20. Global cotton production estimates also has been reduced to 24.7 million tons with consumption currently remaining at 24.3 million tons in 2020-21. Global trade is estimated at 9.4 million tons for 2020-21. World ending stocks are currently estimated to increase by 2.0% to 21.655 million tons in 2020-21 season.




