

DOMESTIC COTTON CROP SCENARIO

The first meeting of Cotton Crop Assessment Committee was held at Islamabad on 04.10.2019 under the Chairmanship of Additional Secretary, Ministry of National Food Security & Research. The representatives from Provincial governments and other stake holders explained the methodology and gave the estimates for crop assessment. Owing to challenges faced by the cotton crop especially high input prices, insect pests pressure and higher temperature, the Committee assessed the volume of current crop at 10.200 million bales. Province-wise assessment of cotton crop is presented in table as below:



Figure-I: SEED COTTON PRICES DURING SEPTEMBER, 2019



Figure-II: COTTON SEED PRICES DURING SEPTEMBER, 2019



Figure-III: COTTON SEED CAKE PRICES DURING SEPTEMBER, 2019



COTTON YARN PRICES:

The Cotton Yarn prices of 21's and 30's count witnessed sluggish trend during the month of September,2019. The prices were recorded at Rs.1,656 and Rs.1832 per bundle of 4.5 kg respectively as compared to Rs.1677 and Rs.1872 in previous month. However, the same counts in the corresponding month of last year were recorded much lower at Rs. 1,490 and Rs.1,696 per bundle respectively. Details are given as below:

The table above indicates that the exports of raw cotton and it's related produce posted gains except Towels and Readymade garments during the month of August, 2019. The raw cotton exports increased to 2,677 metric tons valuing Rs. 657 million as compared to 2,660 metric tons amounting to Rs. 658 million in July, 2019. However, the exports in August, 2018 recorded lower at 1,618 metric tons amounting to Rs. 296 million, showing an increase of 0.64 percent in quantity but 0.15 percent decline in value over July, 2019.

The table above shows that the imports of raw cotton during August, 2019 remained decreased to 3,358 metric tons amounting to Rs.997 million as compared to 14,562 metric tons valuing Rs.4,345 million in July,2019. Whereas the imports in August, 2018 recorded much higher at 7,217 metric tons amounting to Rs.1,827 million, showing a decline of 76.94 percent in quantity and 77.05 percent in value over July, 2019.

ECONOMICS OF COTTON AND COMPETING CROPS

Cotton a Kharif crop, competes with rice, sugarcane and other crops for land, water and other farm resources in the area where the cultivation of all other crops is technically feasible. Mainly cotton faces indirect competition from sugarcane, the annual crop which keeps the land throughout the year. The farmer gives priorities and takes decision on the economics of cotton and competing crops on the basis of inputs-outputs prices paid and received. The estimation of the indicators, like gross cost, gross income, gross margin, net income, input-output ratio, etc may provide the useful sights to the growers at farm level. Details are presented in following table.

REGIONAL COTTON SITUATION





Cotton area in China has decreased slightly by 2.0% to 3.300 million hectares in 2019-20 and yields are currently expected to decline due to high temperature and little rain in the Xinjiang region. The production currently forecasted in 2019-20 is 4% lower than the previous year. Consumption in China is expected to remain flat in 2019-20 at 8.25 million tons. Imports by China are projected at 2.1 million tons, indicating an increase of 1.0% over previous season. Stock levels in China continued to decline and are expected to decrease in 2019-20 by 5% to 8.5 million tons.

Cotton area in India is projected to remain unchanged at 12.20 million hectares in 2019-20. Favorable weather conditions in India could potentially increase output more than 6% production growth currently expected. Similarly, mill consumption is expected to rise by 2.5% to 5.535 million tons as compared to 5.400 million tons in 2018-19. Exports from India estimated to rise by 12.5 percent to 0.900 million tons in current year as compared to 0.800 million tons in previous year.

3. INTERNATIONAL COTTON SITUATION 2019-20



World cotton area is expected to grow by 5.8% to 34.461 million hectares in 2019-20 as compared to 32.582 million hectares in 2018-19. Global cotton production is expected to increase by 5% to 26.9 million tons, while consumption is projected to rise by 1.0% to 26.7 million tons. Global trade and economic growth slowdowns have impacted cotton demand with global trade growing 2% in 2018-19 at 9.3 million tons with a 1.2% increase in global consumption. Ending stocks in 2019-20 are estimated to grow by 1.3% to 18.324 million tons. Favorable forecasts for production and increasing world stock levels in 2019-20 continue to place downward pressure on prices.


