

DOMESTIC COTTON CROP SCENARIO

Cotton arrivals into ginning factories stood at 8.571 million bales as on 15th March,2020 as reported by Pakistan Cotton Ginner's Association. It indicates a decline of 20.4% over the previous season. Volume of crop both in Punjab and Sindh witnessed decrease by 22.9% to 5.097 million bales and 16.3% to 3.474 million bales, respectively. Better initiatives have been taken by the Federal Government to increase the area of cotton in the next year. To increase the production of cotton, pure seed will be supplied to farmers and complete measures will be taken to combat with pest attack, like white fly and pink boll worm.

For the assessment of indicative cotton price, high level committee has been constituted by the Government to safe guard the interest of farmer, resulting sowing area will be increased by announcement of support price.



Figure-II: COTTON SEED PRICES DURING MARCH, 2020



COTTON YARN PRICES:

The Cotton Yarn prices of 21's and 30's count in March,2020 remained stable at previous month's level of Rs 1,656 and Rs.1,832 per bundle of 4.5 kg respectively. However, the same counts in the corresponding month of last year were recorded lower at Rs.1,537 and Rs.1,788 per bundle respectively. Details are given as below:

The table above indicates that the exports of raw cotton and it's related produce witnessed increasing tendency except cotton yarn and synthetic fiber during February,2020. The raw cotton exports increased to 701 metric tons valuing Rs. 141 million as compared to 420 metric tons amounting to Rs.86 million in January, 2020. However, the exports in February, 2019 recorded at 482 metric tons amounting to Rs. 116 million, showing an increase of 66.90 percent in quantity and 63.95 percent in value over January, 2020.

The table above shows that the imports of raw cotton during February, 2020 posted gains to 117,787 metric tons amounting to Rs.30,010 million as compared to 67,698 metric tons valuing Rs.16,720 million in January,2020. Whereas the imports in February, 2019 recorded at 78,131 metric tons amounting to Rs.19,727 million, showing an increase of 73.99 percent in quantity and 79.49 percent in value over January, 2020.

ECONOMICS OF COTTON AND COMPETING CROPS

Cotton a Kharif crop, competes with rice, sugarcane and other crops for land, water and other farm resources in the area where the cultivation of all other crops is technically feasible. Mainly cotton faces indirect competition from sugarcane, the annual crop which keeps the land throughout the year. The economics of cotton and competing crops has been analyzed on the basis of inputs-outputs costs paid and received growers during 2016-17 year. The summary of various indicators for Punjab and Sindh are presented in table as under:

REGIONAL COTTON SITUATION

1. CHINA

Cotton area in China has declined by 2.0% to 3.300 million hectares in 2019-20 as compared to 3.367 million hectares in 2018-19. The production in china is expected to decrease by 4% to 5.8 million tons in 2019-20. Similarly, consumption is expected to decline by 13.82% to 7.11 million tons in 2019-20. Imports by China are projected at 1.863 million tons, indicating a decline of 11.43% over previous season. Stock levels in China is projected to increase by 5.74% to 9.39 million tons in 2019-20.

2. INDIA

Cotton area in India is estimated to increase by 0.8% to 12.7 million hectares in 2019-20 as compared to 12.6 million hectares in 2018-19. Production in India is projected to grow by 12% to 6.0 million tons in 2019-20 owing to favorable weather conditions. Mill consumption is expected to decline by 5.0% to 5.13 million tons as compared to 5.40 million tons in 2018-19. Exports from India are projected to rise by 7.5 percent to 0.86 million tons in current year as compared to 0.80 million tons in previous year.

3. INTERNATIONAL COTTON SITUATION 2019-20

World cotton area is expected to grow by 2.30% to 33.774 million hectares in 2019-20 as compared to 33.015 million hectares in 2018-19. Similarly, Global cotton production is estimated to increase by 0.81% to 25.892 million tons in 2019-20 as compared to 25.684 million tons in 2018-19. While consumption is estimated to decline by 5.5% to 24.588 million tons in 2019-20. Global trade i.e imports and exports are estimated to rise by 1.1% to 9.290 million tons in 2019-20. World ending stocks are currently estimated to increase by 7.09% to 19.7 million tons in 2019-20 season.





The graph above shows that the nearby May, 2020 contract during March, 2020 eased to 58.00 cents per pound as compared to 67.00 cents in previous month. However, the prices of same contract in the corresponding month of last year recorded much higher at 75.00 cents per pound.
