DOMESTIC COTTON CROP SCENARIO

According to the report released by Pakistan Cotton Ginner's Association as on 1st January,2020 the arrivals of seed cotton into ginning factories witnessed decline of 20.8% to 8.139 million bales as compared to 10.274 million bales recorded in the corresponding period last year. The arrivals in Punjab declined by 23.8 percent to 4.694 million bales as compared to 6.163 million bales in last year.

Similarly, the arrivals in Sindh also remained decreased by 16.2 percent to 3.446 million bales as compared to 4.111 million bales in the same period of last year. However, the district of Bahawal Nagar, Pak Pattan and Okara in Punjab and Mirpur Khas and Badin in Sindh depicted growing tendency as compared to previous year. The key factors of decline in production both in Punjab and Sindh were extra ordinary temperature rise (day and night) during the month of September,2019, thereby hampering the late season fruit development. Similarly, irrigation-water shortage in Sindh especially at critical stages of crop development, severe attack of Pink boll worm both in Punjab and Sindh, white fly attack and lower seed cotton prices with rising input costs remained key elements for affecting cotton production.



Figure-I: SEED COTTON PRICES DURING DECEMBER, 2019



Figure-II: COTTON SEED PRICES DURING DECEMBER, 2019



Figure-III: COTTON SEED CAKE PRICES DURING DECEMBER, 2019



COTTON YARN PRICES:

The Cotton Yarn prices of 21's and 30's count in December,2019 remained unchanged at previous month's level of Rs 1,656 and Rs.1,832 per bundle of 4.5 kg respectively. However, the same counts in the corresponding month of last year were recorded lower at Rs.1,536 and Rs.1,788 per bundle respectively. Details are given as below:

The table above indicates that the exports of raw cotton, cotton yarn, knitwear and readymade garments witnessed rising tendency but other related produce remained eased during November,2019. The raw cotton exports increased to 1,544 metric tons valuing Rs. 321 million as compared to 974 metric tons amounting to Rs. 216 million in October, 2019. However, the exports in November, 2018 recorded lower at 919 metric tons amounting to Rs. 221 million, showing an increase of 58.52 percent in quantity and 48.61 percent in value over October, 2019.

The table above shows that the imports of raw cotton during November, 2019 posted gains to 8,990 metric tons amounting to Rs.2,551 million as compared to 5,548 metric tons valuing Rs.1,440 million in October,2019. Whereas the imports in November, 2018 recorded at 9,894 metric tons amounting to Rs.2,501 million, showing an increase of 62.04 percent in quantity and 77.15 percent in value over October, 2019.

ECONOMICS OF COTTON AND COMPETING CROPS

Cotton a Kharif crop, competes with rice, sugarcane and other crops for land, water and other farm resources in the area where the cultivation of all other crops is technically feasible. Mainly cotton faces indirect competition from sugarcane, the annual crop which keeps the land throughout the year. The farmer gives priorities and takes decision on the economics of cotton and competing crops on the basis of inputs-outputs prices paid and received. The estimation of the indicators, like gross cost, gross income, gross margin, net income, input-output ratio, etc may provide the useful sights to the growers at farm level. Details are presented in following table.

REGIONAL COTTON SITUATION

1. CHINA

Cotton area in China has decreased slightly by 2.0% to 3.300 million hectares in 2019-20 as compared to 3.367 million hectares in 2018-19. Yield also is expected to decline due to high temperature and little rain. The production forecasted in 2019-20 is 4% lower than the previous year. Consumption in China is expected to decline by 2.4% to 8.05 million tons in 2019-20. Imports by China are projected at 1.66 million tons, showing a decrease of 21.0% over previous season. Stock levels in China continued to decline by 7.3% to 8.2 million tons in 2019-20.

2. INDIA

Cotton area in India is projected to enhance at 12.7 million hectares in 2019-20. Favorable weather conditions in India could potentially increase 12.0% in production currently expected. Similarly, mill consumption is expected to rise by 2.5% to 5.535 million tons as compared to 5.400 million tons in 2018-19. Exports from India estimated to rise by 12.5 percent to 0.900 million tons in current year as compared to 0.800 million tons in previous year.

3. INTERNATIONAL COTTON SITUATION 2019-20

World cotton area is expected to grow by 4.2% to 34.349 million hectares in 2019-20 as compared to 32.963 million hectares in 2018-19. Global cotton production is expected to increase by 1.2% to 26.01 million tons, while consumption is projected to rise by 0.4% to 26.2 million tons. Global trade i.e imports and exports are estimated to decline at 9.0 million tons in 2019-20 as compared to 9.2 in 2018-19. World ending stock levels are currently projected to increase by 1% by the end of 2019-20 under current estimates for production and consumption. With current projections of increase in global cotton production and weak consumption, cotton prices are expected to remain low in the new year.



The graph above indicates that the nearby March, 2020 contract during December, 2019 posted gains to 67.00 cents per pound as compared to 64.00 cents in previous month. However, the prices of same contract in the corresponding month of last year recorded much higher at 77.00 cents per pound.
