

The sowing of cotton crop both in Punjab and Sindh is in progress. Area sown in Punjab as reported by Agriculture (Extension & AR) Punjab, Lahore till 1st week of May, 2020 was not satisfactory and recorded at 1.244 million acres which comprises only 25% of the tentative target and about 21% less than the previous year. Whereas the area sown in Sindh witnessed increase of 28% over last year, achieving 43% against target. The main districts of Sindh which showed great performance against their target are Hyderabad 95%, Tando Muhammad Khan 95%, Tando Allah Yar 91%, Mirpur Khas 90%, Umer Kot 81% and Sanghar 81%. This year, cotton sowing in Sindh is being reported on more area as compared to corresponding period of last year. Due to low germination of seed, growers are applying increased seed rate per acre.

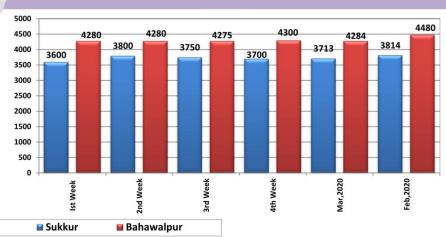

Figure-II: COTTON SEED PRICES DURING MARCH, 2020

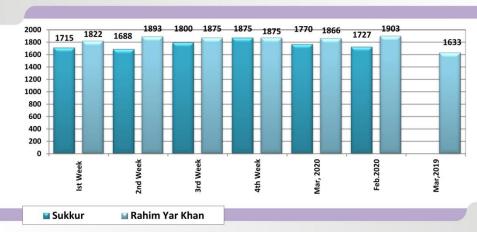

Figure-III: COTTON SEED CAKE PRICES DURING MARCH, 2020

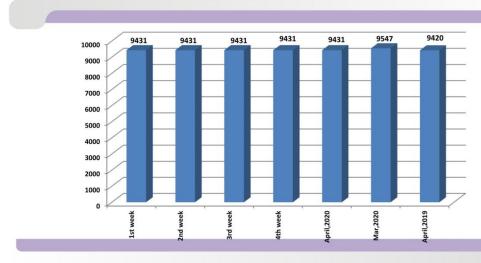

The table above indicates that the exports of raw cotton and it's related produce witnessed decreasing tendency except synthetic fiber during March,2020. The raw cotton exports decreased to 155 metric tons valuing Rs. 33 million as compared to 701 metric tons amounting to Rs.141 million in February, 2020. However, the exports in March, 2019 recorded at 307 metric tons amounting to Rs. 61 million, showing a decrease of 77.89 percent in quantity and 76.60 percent in value over February, 2020.

The table above indicates that the imports of raw cotton during March, 2020 decreased to 101,600 metric tons amounting to Rs.26,384 million as compared to 117,787 metric tons valuing Rs.30,010 million in February,2020. Whereas the imports in March, 2019 recorded at 71,785 metric tons amounting to Rs.18,388 million, showing a decrease of 13.74 percent in quantity and 12.08 percent in value over February, 2020.

### **ECONOMICS OF COTTON AND COMPETING CROPS**

Cotton a Kharif crop, competes with rice, sugarcane and other crops for land, water and other farm resources in the area where the cultivation of all other crops is technically feasible. Mainly cotton faces indirect competition from sugarcane, the annual crop which keeps the land throughout the year. The economics of cotton and competing crops has been analyzed on the basis of inputs-outputs costs paid and received growers during 2016-17 year. The summary of various indicators for Punjab and Sindh are presented in table as under:

## REGIONAL COTTON SITUATION

# 1. CHINA

The area under cotton in China is expected to decrease by 6.6% to 3.08 million hectares in 2020-21season owing to decrease in xinjiang region as farmers have been influenced by lower returns from cotton. Similarly, production is expected to decline by 6% to 5.454 million tons in 2020-21 as compared to 5.800 million tons in 2019-20. Whereas, consumption is projected to increase by 2.0% to 7.096 million tons in 2020-21. Imports by China are expected at 1.862 million tons as compared to 1.783 million tons in 2019-20, showing an increase by 4.4% over previous year. Ending stock in China is projected to increase by 6.5% to 9.461 million tons in 2019-20.

# 2. INDIA

India will continue to lead the world in cotton area despite an expected area contraction to 12.06 million hectares in 2020-21 with prices lower than competing crops in the area. Yields in India area expected to be lower as sowing has been delayed from late harvesting of other crops and the containment measures to control the pandemic. Production in India is expected to decline by 7.5% to 5.735 million tons in 2020-21 as compared to 6.200 million tons in 2019-20. However, mill consumption is expected to remain stable at the same level of 4.752 million tons in 2020-21. While exports are projected to rise by 69.0% to 0.893 million tons in 2020-21 as compared to 0.528 million tons in 2019-20.

## 3. INTERNATIONAL COTTON SITUATION 2019-20

Global area under cotton is expected to decline in 2020-21 by 4% to 33 million hectares. Similarly, world production for 2020-21 is expected to decrease by 4% to 25 million tons as against 2019-20 season due to decline in area. Global consumption for 2020-21 is currently expected at 23.2 million tons. With production exceeding consumption in a contracting global economy, stock levels would be expected to increase putting additional pressure on prices.

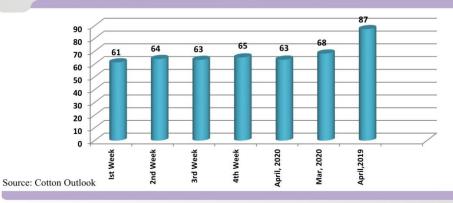

The graph above shows that 'A' index prices during April, 2020 slackened to 63.00 cents per pound as compared to 68.00 cents per pound in March, 2020. However, the prices in April, 2019 were recorded higher at 87.00 cents per pound. Month-wise details are given as below:
