

DOMESTIC COTTON CROP SCENARIO

The second meeting of Cotton Crop Assessment Committee (CCAC) was held on 7th October,2021 under the chairmanship of Federal Secretary for National Food Security & Research, Islamabad. According to estimates released by Cotton Crop Assessment Committee Meeting, the cotton production during the current season will be at 9.374 million bales against the target of 10.5 million bales. The Punjab is estimated to produce 5.44 million bales, Sind is estimated 3.5 million bales, whereas KPK and Baluchistan will produce 0.004 million and 0.43 million bales, respectively. It has been reported that the weather and prices factor favored the cotton production. The government announcement of intervention price enhanced the growers' confidence in investment on crop management resulted in higher arrivals of cotton in ginneries. Province - wise first & Second assessment of cotton production is given as below:



Figure-I: SEED COTTON PRICES DURING SEPTEMBER, 2021



COTTON YARN PRICES:

The Cotton Yarn prices of 21's and 30's count witnessed rising tendency during the month of September, 2021. The prices of 21's and 30's count were recorded at Rs.2,516 and Rs.2,808 per bundle of 4.5 kg respectively as compared to Rs.2,480 and Rs.2,755 per bundle in previous month. However, the prices of same counts in the corresponding month were registered much lower at Rs.1681 and Rs 1868 per bundle, respectively. Details are given as below:

The table above shows that raw cotton was not exported but its related produce witnessed decreasing tendency except cotton yarn and cotton cloth during the month of August, 2021. However, the raw cotton exports in corresponding month last year were recorded at 206 metric tons amounting to Rs. 39 Million.

The table above indicates that the imports of raw cotton during August, 2021 posted gains and recorded at 53238 metric tons amounting to Rs.17885 million as compared to 49170 metric tons valuing Rs.15666 million in July,2021. Whereas the imports in August, 2020 placed much lower at 41974 metric tons amounting to Rs. 11310 million, showing a rise of 8.3 percent in quantity and 14.1 percent in value over July, 2021.

ECONOMICS OF COTTON AND COMPETING CROPS

Cotton a Kharif crop, competes with rice, sugarcane and other crops for land, water and other farm resources in the area where the cultivation of all other crops is technically feasible. Mainly cotton faces indirect competition from sugarcane, the annual crop which keeps the land throughout the year. The economics of cotton and competing crops has been analyzed on the basis of inputs-outputs costs paid and received growers during 2019-20 year. The summary of various indicators for Punjab and Sindh are presented in table as under:

REGIONAL COTTON SITUATION



1. CHINA

Cotton area in China is projected to reduce by 2.0% to 3.11 million hectares in 2021-22 season as compared to 3.2 million hectares in 2020-21. Similarly cotton production is expected to decrease by 3.0% to 5.7 million tons in 2021-22 as compared to 5.9 million tons in last year. Consumption also is estimated to reduce by 2.4% to 8.20 million tons in 2021-22. Imports by China are estimated at 2.64 million tons, indicating decline by 5.7% over previous season. Stock level in China are estimated at 9.248 million tons in 2020-21.

2. INDIA

Cotton area in India is expected to decrease by 6.14 percent to 12.650 million hectares in 2021-22 as compared to 13.477 million hectares in previous year. Similarly production has been revised down ward to 5.9 million tons, showing 2.1 % decline from last season. Whereas, mill consumption is expected to grow by 5.0.% to 5.9 million tons in 2021-22 due to recovering demand for cotton yarn in its domestic markets. Indian exports are expected to decline by 16.7 percent to 1.12 million tons for the season 2021-22. Ending stocks are expected at 2.68 million tons in 2020-21.

3. INTERNATIONAL COTTON SITUATION 2020-21



World cotton area for the 2021-22 season is expected to increase by 3.5% to 33.183 million hectares as compared to 32.054 million hectares in previous year. Global production is expected to show a recovery by 6.0% in 2021-22 season and is recorded at 25.7 million tons as compared to 24.2 million tons in 2020-21. Global consumption also has recovered from 2020-21 by 0.8% to reach 25.903 million tons in 2021-22. Ending stocks are forecast to decline further in 2020-21 season to 20.111 million tons as compared to 22.144 million tons in previous year.





The graph above indicates that the nearby October, 2021 contract during September, 2021 witnessed nominal rise to 95.38 cents per pound as compared to 93.41 cents in previous month.
