



DOMESTIC COTTON CROP SCENARIO

Cotton crop has almost terminated in Sindh, however arrivals are still being reported in Sukkur & Ghotki districts. Picking was delayed in Punjab during last two weeks of October & first week of November, 2017 however, the pace has accelerated and frequency of arrivals has increased. About 80% of the arrivals have been reported in ginneries and 20% of crop is about to arrive in the ginneries.

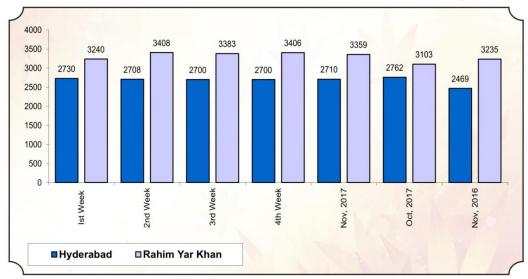

Figure -I: SEED COTTON PRICES DURING NOVEMBER, 2017

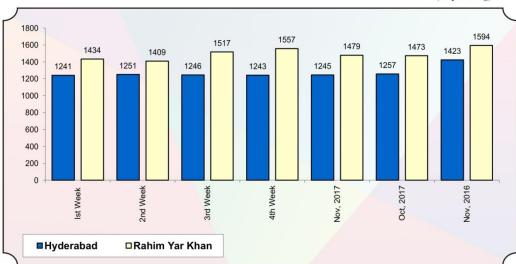

Figure-II: COTTON SEED PRICES DURING NOVEMBER, 2017

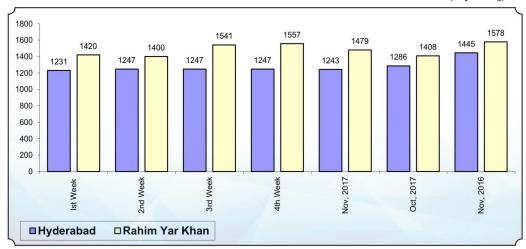

Figure-III COTTON SEED CAKE PRICES DURING NOVEMBER, 2017

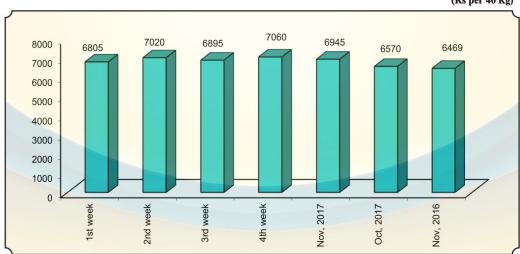

The table above shows that the exports of raw cotton witnessed declining tendency but other related produce posted gains during the month of October, 2017. The raw cotton exports decreased to 7,901 metric tons valuing Rs.1,363 million as compared to 12,500 metric tons worth Rs.2,204 million in September, 2017. However, the exports in October, 2016 recorded at 6,711 metric tons amounting to Rs.1,209 million showing decrease of 36.8% in quantity and 38.2% in value over September,2017.

The table above indicates that the imports of raw cotton during October, 2017 posted gains to 10,012 metric tons amounting to Rs.1850 million as compared to 2,860 metric tons valuing Rs.435 million in September,2017. Whereas the imports in October, 2016 recorded at 17,637 metric tons amounting to Rs.3,090 million, showing an increase of 250.07 percent in quantity and 325.29 percent in value over September, 2017.

ECONOMICS OF COTTON AND COMPETING CROPS

Cotton a kharif crop, competes with rice, sugarcane and other crops for land, water and other farm resources in the area where the cultivation of all other crops is technically feasible. Mainly cotton faces indirect competition from sugarcane, the annual crop which keeps the land throughout the year. The farmer gives priorities and takes decision on the economics of cotton and competing crops on the basis of inputs-outputs prices paid and received. The estimation of the indicators, like gross cost, gross income, gross margin, net income, input-output ratio, etc may provide the useful sights to the growers at farm level. Details are presented in following table.

REGIONAL COTTON SITUATION



1. CHINA

Cotton area in China is projected to rise by 7% to 3.1 million hectares in 2017-18 as compared to 2.9 million hectares in 2016-17 owing to higher prices in last year. Cotton production in China is also expected to increase by 7% to 5.2 million tons in 2017-18 as compared to 4.9 million tons in 2016-17. Whereas mill use is expected to grow by 1% to 8.1 million tons in 2017-18. Imports by China are projected to increase by 18.0% to 1.3 million tons in 2017-18. China's ending stocks are projected to decline by 16% to 10.6 million tons in 2016-17.

2. INDIA

Cotton area in India is estimated to increase by 9.5% to 11.5 million hectares in 2017-18 as compared to 10.5 million hectares in 2016-17, owing to firm prices in 2016-17. Cotton production in India is projected to grow by 8.7% to 6.2 million tons in 2017-18 as against 5.7 million tons in 2016-17. Mill consumption in India is also likely to grow by 4% to 5.3 million tons in 2017-18. However, exports from India are expected to increase by 8.0% to 1.07 million tons in 2017-18.

INTERNATIONAL COTTON SITUATION 2017-18



The world cotton area in 2017-18 is projected to increase by 11% to 32.5 million hectares as compared to 29.3 million hectares in 2016-17. World cotton production is forecast to grow by 11.7% to 25.7 million tons in 2017-18 as against 23.0 million tons in 2016-17 due to expansion in area. World cotton consumption may recover by 3% to 25.2 million tons in 2017-18 as compared to 24.5 million tons in 2016-17. The world imports and exports are projected to increase by 0.5 percent to 8.1 million tons in 2017-18. The world ending stocks in 2016-17 are expected to decline by 7.4 percent to 18.7 million tons.

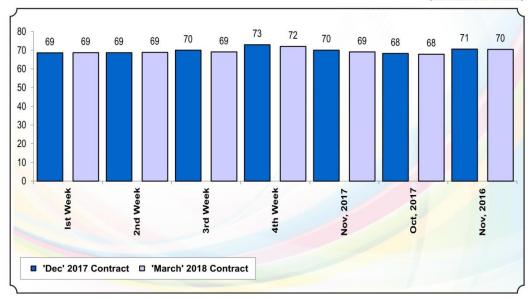
