DOMESTIC AND WORLD COTTON REVIEW



DOMESTIC COTTON CROP SCENARIO

Sowing of cotton crop, 2017-18 has been completed both in Sindh and Punjab. According to final crop report by Crop Reporting Department Punjab, more than 5300,000 acres of cotton have been sown in Punjab as on 07.7.2017 which comprises 88.6% of the target for the year 2017-18. Whereas, about 1503,356 acres of cotton have been sown in Sindh as on 07.7.2017, which comprises 94% of the target for the year 2017-18.



Figure -I: SEED COTTON PRICES DURING JUNE, 2017



Figure-II: COTTON SEED PRICES DURING JUNE, 2017





Figure-III COTTON SEED CAKE PRICES DURING JUNE, 2017



The graph above shows that the prices of raw cotton during the month of June, 2017 were averaged at Rs. 7,196 per 40 kg as compared to Rs. 7,227 in May, 2017. However, the prices in June, 2016 were recorded much lower at Rs. 5,993 per 40 kg. Month-wise details are given in table below:

COTTON YARN PRICES

The Cotton Yarn prices of 21's and 30's counts in June, 2017 remained stable at previous month's level of Rs. 1249 and Rs. 1413 per bundle of 4.54 kg respectively. However, the same counts in the corresponding month of the last year were recorded lower at Rs. 1072 and Rs.1272 per bundle respectively. Details are given as below:

The table above shows that the exports of raw cotton and it's related produce slumped except cotton yarn during the month of May, 2017. The raw cotton exports decreased to 282 metric tons valuing Rs.53 million as compared to 622 metric tons worth Rs.108 million in April, 2017. However, the exports in May, 2016 recorded at 220 metric tons amounting to Rs.35 million showing decline of 54.7% in quantity and 50.9% in value over April,2017.

The table above indicates that the imports of raw cotton during May, 2017 slackened to 72,896 metric tons amounting to Rs.13,427 million as compared to 81,821 metric tons valuing Rs.15,419 million in April,2017. Whereas the imports in May,2016 recorded at 29,813 metric tons amounting to Rs.5426 million, showing decrease of 10.9 percent in quantity and 12.9 percent in value over April ,2017.

ECONOMICS OF COTTON AND COMPETING CROPS

Cotton a kharif crop, competes with rice, sugarcane and other crops for land, water and other farm resources in the area where the cultivation of all other crops is technically feasible. Mainly cotton faces indirect competition from sugarcane, the annual crop which keeps the land throughout the year. The farmer gives priorities and takes decision on the economics of cotton and competing crops on the basis of inputs-outputs prices paid and received. The estimation of the indicators, like gross cost, gross income, gross margin, net income, input-output ratio, etc may provide the useful sights to the growers at farm level. Details are presented in following table.

REGIONAL COTTON SITUATION



1. CHINA

Cotton area in China is expected to rise by 3% to 3.2 million hectares in 2017-18 as compared to 3.1 million hectares in 2017-18 owing to higher prices in 2016-17. Cotton production in China also expected to grow by 3% to 5.0 million tons in 2017-18 as compared to 4.8 million tons in 2016-17. Whereas mill use is forecast to remain unchanged at 7.7 million tons in 2017-18. Imports by China are anticipated to increase by 10% to 1.06 million tons in 2016-17 which is the first increase since 2011-12. China's ending stock are projected to decline by 17% to 9.2 million tons in 2016-17.

2. INDIA

Cotton area in India is forecast to increase by 7% to 11.3 million hectares in 2017-18 as compared to 10.500 million hectares in 2016-17, due to firm prices this season which have encouraged farmers to return to cotton crop. Cotton production in India owing to increase in area is projected to grow by 3% to 6.0 million tons in 2017-18 as against 5.8 million tons in 2016-17.Mill consumption in India is increase likely to grow by 3% to 5.2 million tons in 2017-18. However, exports from India are projected to decline by 2.2% to 930,000 tons in 2017-18.

INTERNATIONAL COTTON SITUATION 2017-18



The world cotton area in 2017-18 is projected to increase by 6.0% to 31.5 million hectares as compared to 29.6 million hectares in 2016-17. World cotton production is forecast to grow by 7% to 24.57 million tons in 2017-18 as against 22.93 million tons in 2016-17 due to high prices in 2016-17 which encouraged farmers to plant more cotton. Global cotton consumption may recover by 1.7% to 24.7 million tons in 2017-18 as compared to 24.3 million tons in 2016-17. The world imports and exports are projected to decrease by 1.1 percent to 7.8 million tons in 2017-18. The world ending stocks in 2016-17 are expected to decline by 7.3 percent to 17.30 million tons.




